Chase Chooses Sage MAS 500

Chase replaced QuickBooks with Sage MAS 500 ERP and a complete suite of financial modules. At the same time, it deployed TempWorks, front-end software designed specifically for temporary staffing companies like Chase, with a custom interface designed by their reseller. The two systems will soon integrate seamlessly, for a smooth end-to-end solution.

“We use Sage MAS 500 for all of our accounting tasks, including general ledger, payables, receivables, purchase orders, and cash management,” explains Lepping. “In addition, we rely on it for sophisticated budgeting and reporting purposes.”

The most dramatic improvement Lepping noticed was in preparing monthly closing statements. “It used to take me four days to prepare a profit and loss report, and I’d have to work all weekend. Now I can do the job in two days—sometimes even one. Our bankers are amazed. They say they don’t know anyone who can do P&Ls in a single day.”

As a result, we have cut processing time by an entire week."

Chase's reseller modified Sage MAS 500 to meet the firm's unique needs. "Our reseller has been absolutely wonderful," says Lepping.
